Explanatory Remarks:

During the inspection it was observed that Northwind Industries (the proponent) was excavating material from the south-west corner of the pit and sorting rock along the north-east corner of the pit.

On November 29, 2024 the proponent requested to extend the pit floor along the east side of the pit by approximately 60-82 meters towards the south. The Department of Environment and Climate Change Land and Water Division (ECC) provided written approval for the request, with the condition that the proponent maintains a 100 meter buffer from Gwich'in Private Lands.

The Department of Environment and Climate Change would like to request a copy of the pre-data as per condition 8 on Quarry Permit 2024QP0001.
