Parsons, on behalf of Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC), for the Giant Mine Remediation Project (GMRP) is notifying the Board and the Land Use Inspector of the following:

1. Rutting occurred in three areas associated with the Brown Line under the New Power Supply Lines and Substations Construction Work Package. The locations were planned disturbances and there is no concern for sediment from disturbed soils conveying to Baker Creek.
2. The first area was previously disturbed and will be further disturbed in the upcoming Highway 4 Upgrade and Office Trailer Complex work starting this summer.
3. The second area under the Brown line will naturally revegetate; working the soil to smooth ruts is not recommended as it could promote soil movement by removing/disturbing vegetative roots binding the soil in place.
4. The third area was previously disturbed, used as a turn-around and will have the ruts smoothed out.
