Hi Rob,

Following up on our call Friday evening, I'm providing information the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB or the Board) has prepared for parties participating in the Giant Mine Remediation Project (GMRP) proceeding. The attached information has been provided by the Board over the last 2-3 months to help people understand the water compensation claim process for the ongoing GMRP proceeding. Notifications of intent to file claims that were received by the Board by the August 15 deadline (as well as other information) can be found on our online registry, under the "Compensation" heading: <https://mvlwb.com/registry/MV2007L8-0031>

In the last week we have had some other parties reach out to us about deadlines for the water compensation process, and following internal discussions, it has been decided that parties who missed the August 15 Notice deadline may still submit a Claim, but must do so by the September 26, 2019 deadline. However, since the August 15, 2019 deadline for the submission of a Notice of Intent to File a Claim (the first step in the Board's Claim for Water Compensation process) has passed, any Claims filed by those who did not submit a Notice must also attach to their Claim a letter to the Board explaining why the process steps were not followed (i.e., the rationale for not providing a Notice by August 15). Please note that it will be the Board's decision whether or not to accept any Claims filed where the established process was not followed.

Any Claims submitted must use the attached Claim Form (MVLWB - Claim Form for Water Compensation (Aug 26 2019).docx).

For your convenience, I have attached the various information items and forms associated with water compensation previously distributed by the Board. These are:

1. MVLWB - Outline of the Legislative Framework for Water Compensation Claims (June 28, 2019).pdf – Provided as information to the GMRP distribution list in late June to assist parties with their understanding of claims for water compensation.
2. MVLWB - Notification Requirements for a Claim for Water Compensation (June 28, 2019).pdf – Information required by any party who planned to submit a Notification of an Intent to file a Claim for Water Compensation. Note that the deadline for those Notices was August 15, 2019.
3. MVLWB - Outline of General Board Process for Considering Claims for Water Compensation (August 26 2019).pdf – Provided as information to the GMRP distribution list in late August to assist parties with their understanding of the Board's process for considering Claims for Water Compensation.
4. MVLWB - Claim Form for Water Compensation (Aug 26 2019).docx – Provided to the parties who submitted Notices of Intent to File a Claim by the August 15 deadline (and posted to the

MVLWB's online Public Registry). This is the form to be used for the September 26, 2019 deadline.

Please note that all information relating to the GMRP proceeding can be found on the Board's online Public Registry at <https://mvlwb.com/registry/MV2007L8-0031> (with items specific to compensation found under the "Compensation" heading).

If you would like to receive information about the GMRP you can sign up to be on the distribution list. You can register through our Online Review System ([http://lwbors.yk.com/LWB\\_IMS/LWBLogin.aspx](http://lwbors.yk.com/LWB_IMS/LWBLogin.aspx)). At the Login page you will notice a highlighted/hyperlinked "register".
