Further to our conversation on June 10, 2014, we have checked the Land Use Application filed for LUP MV2014X0011 and have noted the error in part 16 of the Application form. Although the maps supplied with the application correctly identified the location of the work sites to be covered in the permit, the maximum longitude stated in section 16 does not correspond to cover the western most work area. We apologise for this inadvertent error and would like to request a change to the maximum longitude covered by Land Use permit MV2014X0011 from 123° 55' 10" to 123° 59' 0".
