Hi Susan,

As per **Part D item 14** of the Hamlet's water licence, incineration or burning at the Landfill is prohibited, but the licence does allow for authorization by the Inspector. Seeing as this will be a one-time occurrence, I authorize incineration of the Hamlet's paper records, but this must be done carefully and cautiously. You can use a burn barrel, just ensure it has a spark screen (mesh screen on top) to reduce cinder transport. The paper should be burned in small batches on a controlled fire with consistent heat for a complete combustion (i.e. hole or vent at the bottom of the barrel). ENR would prefer to see these paper records shredded and landfilled, but I understand the with the amount of files on hand this would be extremely labor intensive, hence my authorization to incinerate the Hamlet's records in this special circumstance.

As for the GNWT's records, I would suggest shipping them to Headquarters for proper archiving or disposal, and bill them for the costs to ship. You can contact Julie Rodger or Colleen Anthony (cc'd above) in Yellowknife to assist with management of these GNWT records.

If you have any questions regarding the above or best practices for incineration, please don't hesitate to contact me, or Albert.
