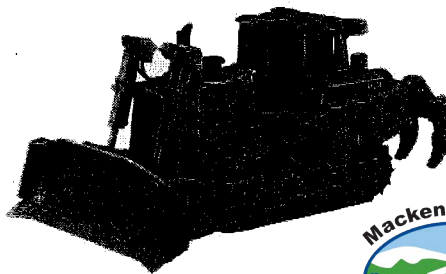

4. We confirm that we operate within the boundaries as specified in Permit # MV2016Q0031


