
Thank you for submitting the final return for Quarry Permit No. 2020QP0017, dated February 2, 2022. Your final return has been reviewed by our Inspector and deemed to be correct.

As you were authorized to remove 20,000 cubic metres of gravel under this permit and report that 15,905 cubic metres was removed, you are entitled to a refund of \$12,285.00. This quarry permit is now closed in our records.

If you do not owe money to the GNWT, you may receive a refund of \$12,285.00 under separate cover. We draw to your attention the *Financial Administration Act* (S.57), that the Comptroller General may retain money by way of deduction or set-off out of money payable to a person by Government out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund or by a public agency, if that person owes money to Government or a public agency; or Government or a public agency has made an overpayment to that person; or that person received an accountable advance and has not repaid or accounted for it.
