Hi Wendy and Angela,

We are in the process of transitioning the Professional Engineer for Pine Point (our Engineer of Record is the term we use), the role who does our annual inspections and annual reports for the Pine Point facility per our MV2017L2-0007 requirements.

The license states in point 7 that a professional engineer must do the annual inspection and write the report, and defines professional engineer on page 3 as being a professional engineer registered with the NT Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists.

The incoming EoR, Daniel Klassen, is currently registered as a P.Eng. in British Columbia. He is starting the process to be registered in the NT as a mobility applicant. Our annual inspection is planned for July 21, but it is presumed that this process will take longer than 2 weeks – so we would like to seek variance for Daniel to complete the inspection while his registration is in process, and he would be fully registered before the time to submit the report.

I spoke on the phone briefly with Wendy today and she doesn't have concerns if it is ok with the board.
