Hi Mike,

I was speaking with Earle Dumas earlier today and he indicated that you would be the person that could address my request.

We are working with Teck Metals Ltd. to support reclamation planning for the tailings impoundment area at the closed Pine Point Mine. Teck has been conducting water treatment at the site for the past 30 years under an MVLWB water licence. We recently determined that a Land Use permit was

required and in completing the application, we also developed a waste management plan. In the waste management plan, we indicated that household waste was disposed at the Hay River facility. The amount of waste that is being brought to facility is a very small amount. Under current operations, two people are on site that operate the water treatment plant and they are typically present for three to twelve weeks per year. I suspect that they only generate a garbage bag per month including refuse from the water treatment operations, which would include some packaging and paper, but no industrial or hazardous waste. Hazardous waste that might be generated include batteries for hand held instruments that are typically taken off-site for recycling.

One of the conditions of the Land Use Permit was that we get 'confirmation from the facility that it will accept Teck's waste'. It would be appreciated if you could provide an email regarding accepting Teck's waste. That would adequately address the comment and the waste management plan will be deemed complete by the MVLWB. If Teck's household waste would not be accepted or if you have any questions, please phone me at 403-614-4391.
