Re: Land Use Permit 2-Year Extension Request

This is to advise you that we are formerly requesting a 2-year extension for Land Use Permit #MV2017Q0033 as per *Subsection 26(6)* of the *Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations* as the permit is set to expire on May 23, 2023.

The main reason for the extension request is a result of the depleting availability of pit run gravel at the quarry site located at KM 518, Hwy #1. During the summer of 2022, crews were attempting to stock pile pit run gravel without much success as a high-water table inundated the material. It is our assessment that source material at this quarry site will not be available beyond the end of this request. The current status of the land use operation will also not be amended during the extension period.

This request will also afford Nogha Enterprises Ltd time to explore options for a replacement quarry that will meet the needs of the company for future revenue opportunities.




