Seabridge Gold NWT Inc. does not plan to undertake any winter mobilization or winter exploration activities at its Courageous Lake project this year under the following regulatory instruments:

- Land Use Permit: MV2019C0025
- Quarry Permit: 2019QP0036
- Water Licence: MV2019L2-0011 (Territorial lands)
- Water Licence: MV2019L2-0012 (Federal lands)
- Surface Lease: 76D3-6-6 (Matthews Lake camp)

As such, Seabridge does not intend to provide monthly reports related to quarry volumes or water use.

The annual water license reports for 2020 will be submitted prior to their due dates.

We will notify you at a later date if Seabridge decides to undertake any summer activities.
