Good morning,

This email is intended to provide a brief update about anticipated activities during 2022 by Seabridge Gold NWT Inc. for its Courageous Lake project.

- There will be no winter mobilization or winter exploration activities at the Courageous Lake project.
- A brief 3-4 day trip will occur this summer to inspect the existing Matthews Lake camp facilities and implement any necessary urgent repairs. We will also download data from our remote wildlife cameras and meteorological station. Minor archaeological field work may also be undertaken. No exploration activities, such as drilling, are planned this year.
- Seabridge published its inaugural Sustainability Report a few weeks ago. The report can be viewed/downloaded from our website:

- The annual Courageous Lake water license report for 2021 was submitted to the MVLWB on January 10, 2022, and should be available on the MVLWB public registry within a few days.
- Seabridge anticipates applying for three permits this spring. Prior to submitting to the respective regulatory body, we will send a draft version of each application to interested Indigenous groups for their review and consideration.
 - Wildlife Permit – renew existing wildlife permit which expires in May2022 - to continue remote camera monitoring of wildlife/caribou in vicinity
 - Archaeology Permit – to authorize potential archaeology fieldwork
 - Quarry Permit – renew existing quarry permit which expires in August 2022 – to authorize removal of gravel from existing quarry.
- Seabridge will continue to maintain our other permits in good standing throughout the year, but due to inactivity no monthly reporting will be required until the summer:
 - Land Use Permit: MV2019C0025
 - Quarry Permit: 2019QP0036
 - Water Licence: MV2019L2-0011 (Territorial lands)

- Water Licence: MV2019L2-0012 (Federal lands)
- Surface Lease: 76D3-6-6 (Matthews Lake camp)
