Subject: Notice of Commencement of limited summer program - Courageous Lake -

Good morning,

Seabridge Gold (NWT) Ltd wishes to inform you that we intend to commence a brief summer field program at our Courageous Lake Property. The field program will consist of limited camp operations to conduct minor maintenance of the camp infrastructure, as required, and to support data downloading and servicing of meteorological equipment and wildlife cameras. There will be no mineral exploration drilling or other exploration activities.

The field activities will be managed by *Matrix Camps, Logistics and Aviation Management*.

- The Matthews Lake camp is expected to be occupied by about 6-8 people for approximately 7 days, and is **tentatively scheduled between June 17 and 24, 2023**
- Activities will be supported by both helicopter and fixed wing aircraft. Fixed wing aircraft will use the existing Tundra/Salmita airstrip.
- There are no plans to extract any material from the Treeline borrow pit near the camp.
- The camp will have a satellite phone however it will not be monitored 24/7.
- I will provide a follow-up email with contact information for the camp and key personnel once these details are available.

The personnel conducting this field work will follow the conditions and procedures outlined in our surface lease (76D/3-6-6), land use permit (MV2019C0025) and approved management plans – and they have been provided copies of all relevant documents.
