# 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Report is to present to the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB/the Board) a compliance date change request submitted by Northwest Territories Power Corporation (NTPC) for Water Licence (Licence) MV2019L1-0001.

# 2. Background

- October 18, 2019 Issuance of Licence MV2019L1-0001;
- April 23, 2020 Request received;
- April 23, 2020 Request deemed complete and review commenced;
- May 12, 2020 Reviewer comments and recommendations due and received;
- May 15, 2020 Responses due and received;
- May 28, 2020 Request presented to the Board for decision; and
- October 17, 2044 Expiration of Licence MV2019L1-0001.

## 3. Discussion

On October 18, 2019, NTPC received a Type A Water Licence for the operation of the Jackfish Power Generating Facility (Jackfish). When the Licence was issued there were a number of items required to be submitted for Board approval.

On April 23, 2020, the Board received a request from NTPC to change the submission dates of the required reports and studies. The table below outlines the request put forward by NTPC.

The Licence also requires all volume and temperature measurements to be recorded continuously during periods of discharge, this required upgrades to the instrumentation. The current system allows for the temperature data to be recorded by not the continuous flow. The temperature and flow data are required for the initial design of the Thermal Plume Delineation Study Design to ensure that the correct area is being monitored.

NTPC initially met with Board staff and requested an extension to the submission date of the Thermal Plume Delineation Study for the ability to complete the instrumentation upgrade. However, to account for the COVID-19 delays and to allow time for current operation conditions to pass and/or detailed policies to be developed to complete work under current conditions NTPC is requesting the submission date change.

All of the changes that are being requested by NTPC are interconnected, the correct instrumentation is required for the completion of the Thermal Plume Study Design, and in turn NTPC will need the Thermal Plume Study Design to be approved to complete the work which will feed into the Thermal Plume Delineation Study Report which in turn assists with the design of the AEMP.

In the Licence, Part B, condition 13 states:

The Schedules and any compliance dates specified in this Licence may be updated at the discretion of the Board.

This condition Licence allows the Board to make change to the Schedules and submission dates without a public hearing or Ministerial approval, even though this is a Type A Water Licence.

# 4. Comments

Board staff have worked with NTPC to ensure that the proposed schedule of the submissions will work with the information requirements needed to progress each of the Reports/Studies/Designs.

# 5. Public Review

By May 12, 2020, comments and recommendations on the Request were received from 2 reviewers:

- Government of the Northwest Territories Environment and Natural Resources; and
- North Slave Métis Alliance.

There were no concerns identified during the review of this Request.

# 6. Security

On May 4, 1988, NTPC was witnessed as a crown corporation when the Northern Canada Power Commission was acquired from Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada by the Government of the Northwest Territories. As a Crown Corporation, NTPC is exempt from paying security depositions or fees in relation to its hydro facility.

Security is not applicable to this Project as per section 94 of the Mackenzie Valley Resource Management Act (MVRMA) because the territorial government is not required to post security pursuant to section 71 of the MVRMA.

#### 7. Conclusion

Based on the information provided in the application and the public review, the proposed changes are not likely to have a significant adverse impact on the environment or be a cause of public concern.

The draft Licence condition changes (highlighted) have been attached for the Board consideration.

Board staff conclude there are no outstanding issues or concerns with this Request.

## 8. Recommendation

Board staff recommend the Board:

- a) Make a motion to approve the change to the submission date for the Thermal Plume Delineation Study Design as required by Part E condition 4 to May 29, 2020 as requested by Northwest Territories Power Corporation for Licence MV2019L1-0001,
- b) Make a motion to approve the change to the submission date for the Thermal Plume Delineation Study Report as required by Part E, condition 5 to December 31, 2021 as requested by Northwest Territories Power Corporation for Licence MV2019L1-0001,
- c) Make a motion to approve the change to the submission date for the AEMP Design Plan as required by Part F, condition 2 to March 31, 2022 as requested by Northwest Territories Power Corporation for Licence MV2019L1-0001.
