**Subject: Boat Launch Replacement, Prosperous Lake, Yellowknife – Serious Harm to Fish and Prohibited Effects on Listed Aquatic Species at Risk Can Be Avoided or Mitigated 18-HCAA-01126**

Dear Heidi Kane:

The Fisheries Protection Program (the Program) of Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) received your proposal on November 30, 2018. We understand that you propose to:

- Construct a new boat ramp and docks

Our review considered the following information:

- Request for Review form, email correspondence and engineer's drawings received January 29, 2019.

Your proposal has been reviewed to determine whether it is likely to result in serious harm to fish which is prohibited under subsection 35(1) of the *Fisheries Act* unless authorized. Your proposal has also been reviewed to determine whether it is likely to affect listed aquatic species at risk, any part of their critical habitat or the residences of their individuals in a manner which is prohibited under sections 32, 33 and subsection 58(1) of the *Species at Risk Act*, unless authorized.

Provided that your plans are implemented in the manner, and during the timeframe, described, the Program has determined that your proposal will not result in serious harm to fish or prohibited effects on listed aquatic species at risk. As such, an authorization under the *Fisheries Act* or a permit under the *Species at Risk Act* is not required.

Should your plans change or if you have omitted some information in your proposal, further review by the Program may be required. Consult our website (<http://www.dfo-mpo.gc.ca/pnw-ppe/index-eng.html>) or consult with a qualified environmental consultant to determine if further review may be necessary. It remains your responsibility to avoid causing serious harm to fish in compliance with the *Fisheries Act*, and avoid prohibited effects on listed aquatic species at risk, any part of their critical habitat or the residences of their individuals in compliance with the *Species at Risk Act*.

It is also your *Duty to Notify* DFO if you have caused, or are about to cause, serious harm to fish that are part of or support a commercial, recreational or Aboriginal fishery. Such notifications should be directed to <http://www.dfo-mpo.gc.ca/pnw-ppe/violation-infraction/index-eng.html>.

A copy of this letter should be kept on site while the work is in progress. It remains your

responsibility to meet all other federal, territorial, provincial and municipal requirements that apply to your proposal.

Good Afternoon,

I'm writing on behalf of the Government of the Northwest Territories, Industry, Tourism & Investment, Tourism and Parks division with regard to some work we are planning at 2 of our Territorial Park boat launches.

I'm not sure these activities will require an assessment, but I've filled out an application that details both projects.

In summary these projects include:

Prelude Lake:

- The replacement of existing deteriorated boat launch infrastructure including gabion baskets, floating dock sections and boat launch ramp;
- The removal of a small boat launch ramp at the end of the breakwater and replacing with a two lane boat ramp and two floating docks;
- The expansion of a portion of the end of the break water to accommodate vehicles and boat trailers turning around.

Prosperous Lake:

- Replacement of existing boat launch and dock section with an additional floating dock and anchors.

Thank you for your review of the project and please contact me if any further detail is required for your assessment.
