I'd like to provide formal notice that construction of the Dempster Fibre Line (DFL) project will be getting underway in the Northwest Territories shortly.

Construction activities for the Dempster Fibre Line project for 2023 began on the Yukon side in May. These activities will be extending their areas of work to the NWT beginning in a week's time. The initial work in NWT will take place between KM 0 and KM 100. DFL Construction activities are summarized in Permit MV2019X0027.

The project team will endeavour to keep communities apprised of construction activities. Regular updates to GNWT, GTC and the communities will be provided on a regular basis by the Project Management team at Rohl.
