Re: Mon Gold Project – Water Licence and Land Use Permit – Assignment – Incomplete – Mining Exploration – Discovery Lake, NT

On October 20, 2023, Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (Board) staff received the Applications to assign Water Licence (Licence) MV2020L2-0002¹ and Land Use Permit (Permit) MV2020C0003² for the Mon Gold Project (Project) from New Discovery Mines Ltd. (New Discovery or Assignor) to Sixty North Gold Mining Ltd. (Sixty North or Assignee).

Board staff have reviewed the Applications and identified missing information required for the Board to process the Applications. For the Applications to be considered complete, refer to the Assignment Application Forms³ and the Land and Water Board (LWB) *Guide to the Water Licensing Process*⁴ and *Guide to the Land Use Permitting Process*⁵ (Guides) and submit the following information to the Board's office:

1. Certificate of Corporate Registration: Provide a copy of the Assignee's current Certificate of Corporate Registration from the Government of the Northwest Territories.

2. Engagement Record: Conduct engagement specific to the proposed assignment and in accordance with the Engagement Plan, Version 11, under the Licence and Permit. Include an Engagement Record in the Applications.
3. Eligibility: Provide confirmation that all appropriate rights, authorizations, permissions, dispositions, and contracts required for the Project have been obtained/transferred or are in the process of being obtained/transferred (e.g., mineral exploration rights, quarry permits, licences of occupation, leases, access agreements and authorizations, etc.) to the Assignee.
4. Other Information: Confirm if the Project will be in a federal or non-federal area. The Licence Assignment Application form indicated that it was non-federal, however, the Permit Assignment Application form indicated that the associated Licence was in a federal area.
5. Assignment Fee: Submit the \$30.00 assignment application fee for the Licence and the \$50.00 assignment application fee for the Permit. If fees were submitted separately, indicate how and when they will be delivered to the Board's office.

Upon receipt of this information, the Board will review the Applications in accordance with the *Waters Act* and the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations. This information should be provided as soon as possible to avoid delays in transferring the Project to the Assignee. Unless the Assignor or Assignee requests additional time, if this information is not provided within 90 days of the date of this letter, the Board will consider the Applications withdrawn.
