Good Morning Everyone,

The City is currently responding to a significant number of water breaks across the City. To ensure the City can continue to maintain levels within the reservoirs, the City has temporarily transitioned its raw water intake from the Yellowknife River to Yellowknife Bay.

This switch is necessary to meet current demand while repairs are underway. Based on current assessments, the City anticipates returning to the Yellowknife River within approximately 48 hours. This timeline is subject to change depending on system conditions and repair progress.

We appreciate your understanding and will provide further updates as needed. Please contact us if you have any questions or concerns.
