Security Deposit for Renewal LUP MV2022J0023 (Expired LUP MV2015J0001)

In review of our records, it's noted that on January 13, 2023, notification from the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB) was received indicating that renewal Land Use Permit MV2022J0023 was issued. This new permit is a renewal of expired Land Use Permit MV2015J0001.

Please refer to Condition #21 of your renewal land use permit which indicates that "prior to commencement of the land-use operation, the Permittee shall deposit with the Minister a security deposit in the amount of \$28,407.00". Currently, the GNWT is holding security in the form of a Letter of Credit in the amount of \$30,000.00 under expired Land Use Permit MV2015J0001. To ensure that you are compliant with your new permit, the Letter of Credit must be amended indicating the new Land Use Permit #MV2022J0001 and, also amending the amount to \$28,407.00.

Please contact your banking Institution and advise them of this requirement. The amendment to the Letter of Credit must be forwarded to us in draft form so that we can review it prior to final submission and acceptance.
