Re. Archaeological Impact Assessment of North Arrow Minerals Inc. DeStaffany Project – Final Report (non-permitted)

The Department of Education, Culture, and Employment (ECE) has reviewed the Archaeological Impact Assessment (AIA) Final Report for the DeStaffany Project. We concur with recommendations for the proposed project as outlined in the AIA.

ECE’s management recommendations include:

Project Component	Recommendation
Exploration Camp and associated Helipad	No further archaeological work is required;
Six Drill Pads	No further archaeological work is required;
Quad Trail/Cutline	Avoidance of Locale 1 and Locale 2 (within archaeological site KbPa-4) is recommended. The proposed avoidance measures outlined in the report for the remainder of site KbPa-4 are sufficient.

In addition, all areas of high archaeological potential identified within the two claims (the project area) which were not subject to assessment under the 2023 AIA require continued avoidance or further AIA work.

Any changes to the scope of the proposed project should be discussed with the project archaeologist and ECE to determine if additional archaeological work is required.
