Please allow me to introduce myself, my name is David MacKeigan and I am a Development Manager with Suncor Energy Products Partnership (Suncor). I am writing to let you know we are planning to upgrade the existing fuel storage facility of the Petro Pass located at 2 Bear Rd. Enterprise NT (60.80922982097023, -115.79283206092643).

This upgrade will require obtaining a land use permit as per Section 4 b) iii of the Mackenzie Valley Land Use Regulations. We are preparing to submit a Land Use Permit Application (LUP) to the Mackenzie Valley Land and Water Board (MVLWB).

The existing fuel storage tank was originally installed in 1997 by Petro Canada and ownership was transferred to Suncor in 2009 when Suncor bought Petro Canada. We are taking a proactive step to replace the existing fuel storage equipment and upgrade the facilities with the latest in fuel storage technology and fuel safety systems.

The proposed activities will take place during the summer/fall of 2021 and 2022 depending on site conditions, availability of equipment, receipt of required approvals and logistical constraints.

General Scope of work will include for the replacement of the existing fuel storage tank, fuel lines and associated equipment, all within the property boundary.
