However, based on the information provided by Paramount, Acho Dene Koe First Nation has concerns with the proposed project and the broadened scope which could further impact the rights of our members."</i> The correspondence also requested some changes to contacts in the Engagemetn Plan and a couple of additional activities to require engagement. Lastly, a meeting was requested to discuss the applications
