Issuance of Quarry Permit at KM 154.8 (Right), NWT Highway No. 3

This letter is to inform you that the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) Department of Environment and Climate Change is issuing a quarry permit at KM 154.8 (Right), NWT Highway No. 3.

BACKGROUND

The Government of the Northwest Territories, Department of Infrastructure (DOI) have applied for a 3-year quarry permit to remove 75,000 cubic metres of limestone bedrock/blast rock for on-going road repairs, resurfacing and culvert replacement of Highway No. 3. The last quarrying permit that DOI held at this location was May 12, 2017, which has expired. It is important to note that the quarry boundaries identified in their application are the same boundaries previously applied for and are not proposed to change.
