Request for Renewal of Type A Land Use Permit MV2017X0020 and Type B Water Licence MV2017L8-0004 for the Checkpoint Project

A Type A land use permit (MV2017X0020) and a Type B water licence (MV2017L8-0004) for the Checkpoint Highway Maintenance and Landfarm project was issued to the Government of the Northwest Territories, Department of Environment and Climate Change (GNWT-ECC), formerly known as Department of Environment and Natural Resources (GNWT-ENR), on June 7, 2017. As this permit and water licence expire on June 6, 2024, this letter is to request the renewal of both the land use permit and water licence.

Ongoing environmental monitoring is taking place at the former Checkpoint Highway Maintenance and Camp at the Landfarm. Renewal of the land use permit and water licence is required to continue care and maintenance, assessment, remediation, monitoring, and decommissioning activities at the former Checkpoint Highway Maintenance Camp and Landfarm. No additional activities are to be added to the scope of work listed as provided in the existing permit and licence.
