We were reminded that employment and protecting the land and water were important, but no concerns were raised. The community is concerned about the cost of the GNWT barge service. We discussed the potential study of a business case for an Indigenously owned barge service for GSL that would service the mine and potentially assist Lutsel K'e. Vital presented a ceremonial donation cheque, and the Chief gave us a tour of the community and surrounding area. I was doing the presenting so Eben may have more to add, but I don't recall the community raising any new significant concerns.
