Hi Natalie,

CIRNAC-Resource and Land Management (RLM) reviewed the proposed Phase II Upper Bosworth Creek Bridge Repair plan provided by Imperial on December 16, 2024. It is understood that Phase II of the proposed repair plan consists of placement of rip rap along the creek-side edge of the sheet pile wall. This work will also require the clearing and grading of an access right-of-way to facilitate access equipment and material access. The work is anticipated to be to be completed under frozen conditions in February 2025. The CIRNAC-RLM Inspectors are supportive of completing Phase II of the Bridge Repair contingent on the following:

- The CIRNAC Inspectors are notified in advance of starting work and following completion
- Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) has confirmed they do not have any concerns with the proposed in-stream activity
- Erosion and sediment control (ESC) measures are implemented and maintained for the duration of the work, and post construction if necessary
- The preventative measures to minimize impact are implemented as described in Imperials December 16, 2024 notification letter.
- All applicable management plans are adhered to such as the following:
 - Environmental Protection Plan
 - Spill Contingency and Response Plan
 - Emergency Response Plan

Please include Erika Nissen, Resource Management Officer (Inspector), and myself in all notifications and correspondence.

Additionally, SLWB has indicated that as-built drawings for both Phase 1 and 2 of the repair work can be submitted within 90 days of the completion of Phase 2 repairs.
