Imperial Oil Resources N.W.T. Limited (Imperial) is submitting this 2024 Annual Report as per Part B, Section 8 of Licence S20L8-005. Beginning October 31, 2021 and no later than every October 31 thereafter, the Licensee is required to submit an Annual Report to the Board and an Inspector containing the below information.

a. Details of Work Completed:

Sahtu Land and Water Board (SLWB) Licence S20L8-005 was obtained on February 4, 2021 and is required in order to quarry sand from the sandbars located downstream of Imperial's Islands 4, 5, and 6 in the Mackenzie River. In 2024, no sand was quarried from the Island 4, 5, or 6 sandbars.

b. Volume of sand removed from each artificial island:

No sand was removed from Island 4, 5, or 6 in 2024.

c. Any other details on waste disposal requested by the Sahtu Land and Water Board:

No additional details regarding waste disposal were requested by SLWB in 2024.
