Good Afternoon,

I am pleased to reach out as the Vice-President of Exploration for Integral Metals, a Canadian-based mineral exploration company. We recently staked six new mineral claims (15 km x 5 km area) in the Mackenzie Mountains to establish the KAP Property – centered at [63.280062° and -126.86263°](#) (*click link to see point on Google Maps*). GNWT-ECC typically does not make an official determination about whether a Minister-approved WMMP is required until after a Land Use Permit and/or Water Licence application has gone through the public review phase. ECC uses the public review part of that process to evaluate and understand people's opinions on the impacts of the project and how the developer is proposing to reduce those impacts. If ECC finds that the impacts of the project on wildlife and wildlife habitat meet certain criteria, then the Minister of ECC lets the developer know that they will require a WMMP for their project.

Hi Jared,

Below you will find links to the Northern Land Use Guidelines and the Sahtú Land Use Plan that discuss the Wildlife Setback Distances and Sensitive Periods in the NWT. In the Land Use Guidelines, Table 2-5 discusses wildlife sensitive periods and recommended minimum setback distances from wildlife habitat and wildlife use areas. I would also recommend looking at Table 2-6 in the guidelines as well, this table refers to recommended minimum flight altitudes and sensitive periods for wildlife. As you operation is helicopter supported. In the Sahtú Land Use Plan, Table 4 displays both Horizontal and Altitude setbacks.
