Good Morning,

We recently staked a series of mineral claims (KAP 1-6; M12414-M12419, M12420) in the Sahtu Dene and Métis Settlement Area within the Mackenzie Mountains (approximately centered at 63.28608°N, 128.86952°W). I would like to notify that we are going to begin the process of applying for a Land Use Permit, in order to perform exploration activities, including:

- Establishing a Remote Camp (less than 400 person-days)
- Storing Fuel (less than 4,000 L)
- Performing Diamond Drilling (less than 2,500 kg)
- Soil and Rock Sampling (walking and hand tools)
- Drone-based Surveys

Can you please provide any guidance on relevant archaeological site data, and help in identifying archaeological site assessment needs?
