Explanatory Remarks:

As stated in the last Inspection Report (July 16, 2022), **Conditions 6.17, 7.6, and 15.3** are unsatisfactory. There have been no improvements in the site conditions; these conditions are still inadequate.

It has been confirmed the area exceeds CCME guidelines (Letter and sample results sent October 9, 2019) for SAR and requires remediation to remedy this issue. Due to the high salt content, Ungulates continue to wallow and create more erosion issues around the sump.

Please submit a detailed plan to the Department of Lands, Sahtu Region, highlighting the methodology and timeline on how EnCana Corporation plans to remediate this site. This plan should be received by the Lands no later than **December 31, 2022**.
