Thank you for your response and for clarifying the situation. We appreciate your willingness to address the oversight regarding the 2023 Annual Report and the updated PCMMP. We've

responded to your questions with some additional info below. If you think a call would still be helpful, we are available on the afternoon of Aug 8 (after 2:30pm). It would be helpful if the Colomac Team could send along any specific questions they might have in advance of a call.

Regarding the confusion about the stability and remediation assessments, it was unclear at first if we were to expect the PCMMP in Spring of 2024 or that the PCMMP would be submitted after the stability and remediation assessments that would be completed in 2024. We now understand that the stability and remediation assessments were to be completed earlier and results provided in the 2023 Annual Report with submission of the PCMMP expected in Spring 2024. As you mentioned, these assessments were not included in the 2023 Annual Report submitted to the Board on May 31, 2024. Thank you for the clarification. Therefore, we expect CIRNAC-CARD to resubmit the 2023 Annual Report with the findings from these assessments

We're not clear on what is meant by the "field monitoring" referenced in your email. If this is something different than the stability and remediation assessments that were anticipated, it would probably be good to discuss this.

With respect to resubmitting Version 6 of the PCMMP, are you able to provide an update on when we would expect this? If the new team hasn't reviewed the Board's [RFD for Version 5 of the PCMMP](#), it is important to note that there is required direction outlined in there for Version 6

The file changed hands and it doesn't look like we followed through on the commitments to provide the status on the Geotechnical recommendations in the 2023 annual report and updated PCMMP as agreed with Beth Cowan last year – we will certainly dig into this and revise as required. Apologies that it was missed.

With regard to your comment about 'confirm if stability and remediation assessments took place in Spring 2024' -I think that there has been a misunderstanding – it was never our intention to conduct any type of geotechnical assessments in Spring 2024. I believe you are referencing Beth's comment that we would provide the outcomes from the summer 2023 field monitoring in the 2023 annual report that we submit in Spring of 2024.
