# 1 Introduction

## 1.1 GENERAL

Rover Metals Corp. ("Rover") is a junior exploration company that is exploring for precious metals (gold) in active mineral claims within "Excluded Parcels" within Tłjcho Government Lands.

Rover is looking to perform mineral exploration work including, but not limited to, geophysical surveying (both ground and airborne), prospecting, sampling, geological mapping, channel sampling using rock saws and diamond-core drilling.

## 1.2 PROJECT BACKGROUND

The Cabin Lake Group Project consists of five mineral claims (Table 1) and three separate land areas:

## Cabin Lake Property




Figure 1. Project Location Map




Figure 2. Cabin Lake Property Location Map

The Cabin Lake property is located at the north end of Russell Lake approximately 40 km from the community of Behchokò and 110 km northwest of Yellowknife (Figure 1 and 2). The property is 100% owned by Rover. The property can be reached by helicopter, float plane, or boat on Russell Lake.

The project is comprised of one active mineral claim located on NTS sheet 085004 (Figure 2) with a total area coverage of 400 hectares. The property is on an "Excluded Parcels" within Tłįcho Government Lands. The area around the claim has been classified as Nawoo Ké Dét'ahot'iı (Cultural Heritage Zone) under the Tłįcho Land Use Plan.

# 2 ENGAGEMENT PLAN

Developing open and transparent communications during the life of the permit and license will provide more clarity and assistance for the process of engaging all parties. Engagement of affected parties and the public in general will help build cooperative working relationships and support for on-going work at the property. It will also serve to bring forward important issues and allow Rover to become better informed on issues affecting First Nations people of the region and the sensitivity of land use operations.

The benefits of the Engagement Plan apply to all stakeholders of the project. The Plan will provide structured dialogue for communications with the various governments and organizations which might be impacted throughout the life of the project. The Plan encompassed in this document will define the ongoing commitment of Rover to the various groups.

The formal engagement and communication process will consist of:

- Communications that ensure adequate time for sharing information and review.
- Open two-way communications with aboriginal governments and organizations to share information and maintain an open dialogue.
- The use of plain language when describing the technical aspects of the program.
- Implementation of the Engagement Plan with follow-up reporting and review.

Types of engagement which will be conducted under the auspices of the Plan will consist of:

- 1. In Person Meetings
- 2. Electronic mail (email)
- 3. Phone
- 4. Fact Sheets
- 5. Community Meetings

In-person meetings will allow for direct discussion of specific issues, initiatives and the addressing of any concerns. Email will allow Rover to communicate with affected parties and obtain their input to address Project-related issues. Fact Sheets will provide clarity of information in plain language to reduce public concerns. Community Meetings would be established to allow the public to hear relevant Project information and provide the opportunity to ask questions and make comments. Rover's goal is to be as transparent as possible in providing firsthand information, engagement and involvement.
